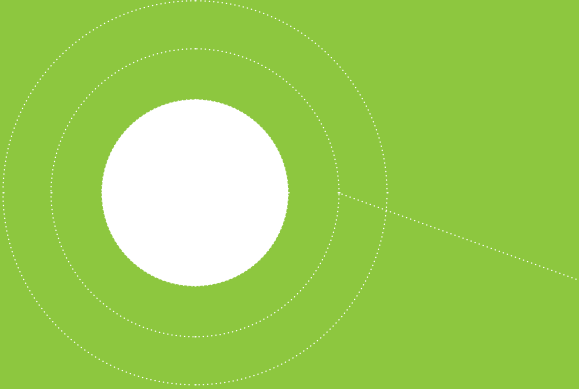




WELCOME TO THE BUILDING!

and no bagged recyclables.

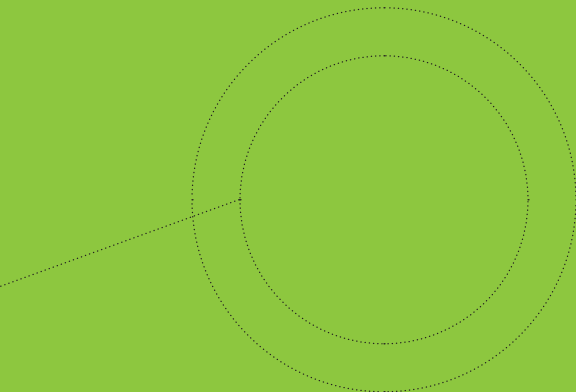
Here are some additional steps to follow to help
your building recycle right:

Keep Plastic Bags Out Of The Recycling

This means that both loose plastic bags and
recyclables inside plastic bags should not go in
recycling bins. If you must collect recyclables in
plastic bags, make sure to empty all recyclables
directly into the main bin, and then throw away
the plastic bag or reuse.
