Right Materials – Right Cart – Know Which Cart to Use

With SB 1383, all food waste and green or yard waste must be separated from trash and placed in your Organics cart.

What goes into the Organics Cart:



Fruits & Vegetables



Meat, Bones & Shells



Eggs, Yogurt & Cheese



Pasta, Beans, Rice, Bread & Cereal



Food-Soiled Paper, Coffee Filters & Tea Bags

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Cart Service Reminders

1. Place all materials in the appropriate container and close the lid.
2. All trash, recyclables and organics outside the cart will not be collected.
3. Place your carts at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on collection day. Emptied carts must be removed from curbside by 6:00 p.m. on the same day.
4. Roll carts into the street and place them against the curb, handles facing your home. Place carts at least two feet apart from other carts and objects.

Bulky Item Collection

Residents receive up to two (2) free bulky item pick-ups per year, with up to three (3) items per pick-up. Additional items may be picked up for a fee. Bulky items cannot exceed 300 lbs. each. Please contact Waste Management Customer Service at least 24 hours in advance of your regular service day to schedule the pick-up.



Acceptable items include: Household furniture and appliances, such as sofas, chairs, washers, dryers, toilets, etc.

Non-acceptable items include: tires, batteries, paints, oils, construction debris, chemicals of any kind, Freon, rocks, sand, gravel, dirt, logs, carpet, hazardous or medical waste or items requiring more than two persons to safely handle.

Holiday Schedule

Collection does not occur on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- 4th of July
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

When a holiday falls on a weekday, collection will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week. If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay in service.

Residents can safely dispose of electronic and household hazardous waste at our facility located at 925 O'Connor St. in El Cajon. Drop-offs are by appointment only and can be made at 619-596-5100.
